Answers and Explanations

1) **A**

Now is the opposite of *later*. *Easy* is the opposite of *difficult*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

2) **C**

Gloves are used to cover the *hands*. *Socks* are used to cover the *feet*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

3) **D**

A characteristic of *lettuce* is to be *green*. A characteristic of a *strawberry* is to be *red*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

4) **A**

A characteristic of *fire* is to be *hot*. A characteristic of a *snow* is to be *frozen*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

5) **C**

India is a type of *country*. *German* is a type of *language*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

6) **B**

You get a *reward* when you do something *good*. You get a *punishment* when you do something *bad*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

7) **C**

Glasses can be used to help someone *see*. A *cane* can be used to help someone *walk*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

8) **D**

Something that is very *interesting* is *fascinating*. Something that is very *uncommon* is *rare*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

9) **B**

Spend is the opposite of *save*. *Give* is the opposite of *receive*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

10) **A**

A *bakery* makes and sells *bread*. A *café* makes and sells *coffee*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.
