I also have a dog. My dog's name is Paw. He is a big dog. He is a brown dog. He is a big brown dog.

1) How many sisters does Eric have?

Answers and Explanations

1) **B**

In paragraph 2, Eric tells us that he has 2 sisters. Choice **(B)** is correct.

2) **C**

In paragraph 3, Eric tells us that his mother is 40 years old. Mother is another word for mom. Choice **(C)** is correct.

3) **B**

In paragraph 4, Eric says, “my father is an engineer.” Father is another word for dad. Choice **(B)** is correct.

4) **B**

In paragraph 5, Eric says, “My dog’s name is Paw.” Choice **(B)** is correct.

5) **C**

In paragraph 5, we learn that Paw is a “brown dog.” Choice **(C)** is correct.

6) **A**

In paragraph 2, Eric tells us that he has two sisters. Eric says, “Rachel is 18 years old. Carrie is 10 years old.” Carrie is younger than Rachel. This makes Carrie Eric’s younger sister. Choice **(A)** is correct.

7) **B**

In paragraph 2, we learn that Eric’s sister Rachel is 18 and Eric’s sister Carrie is 10. Rachel is older than Carrie. This makes Rachel Eric’s older sister. Choice **(B)** is correct.

8) **B**

In paragraph 5, we learn about Eric’s dog, Paw. Eric says, “He is a big dog. He is a brown dog. He is a big brown dog.” Eric’s dog is big, not small. This means **option (I)** is not true. In paragraph 5, we learn about Eric’s dog, Paw. Eric says, “He is a big dog. He is a brown dog. He is a big brown dog.” Eric’s dog is brown. This means **option (II)** is true. Choice **(B)** is correct.
