## Answers and Explanations

1) **B**

The function of a *musician* is to make *music*. The function of a *chef* is to make *food*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

2) **C**

A *whale* lives in the *ocean*. A *tiger* lives in the *jungle*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

3) **C**

Someone who is *terrified* is very *scared*. Someone who is *obsessed* is extremely *interested*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

4) **A**

Someone who is *sad* lacks *happiness*. Someone who is *weak* lacks *strength*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

5) **D**

The *tongue* is used to *taste*. The *nose* is used to *smell*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

6) **A**

A *chair* is used to *sit*. A *cup* is used to *drink*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

7) **D**

A *wrench* is a kind of *tool*. A *carrot* is a kind of *vegetable*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

8) **A**

Something that is *tiny* is very *little*. Something that is *huge* is very *big*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

9) **A**

Someone who is *poor* lacks *money*. Someone who is *tired* lacks *energy*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

10) **A**

Something that is *safe* is not *dangerous*. Something that is *silent* is not *noisy*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.
