Answers and Explanations

1) **A**

An *orphan* is someone whose *parents* have died. Thus, an orphan lacks parents. A *prisoner* lacks *freedom* because he or she is locked up in jail. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

2) **B**

A *mirror* is used to *reflect*. A *telescope* is used to *magnify*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

3) **C**

A *cloth* is made up of *threads*. A *chain* is made up of *links*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

4) **D**

A characteristic of a *tattoo* is to be *permanent*. A characteristic of a *marathon* is to be *long*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

5) **A**

Outdated is the opposite of *modern*, or current. *Beautiful* is the opposite of *ugly*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

6) **D**

Something that is *adorable* is very *cute*. Something that is *tragic* is very *sad*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

7) **D**

Sculpture is a type of *art*. *Weightlifting* is a type of *exercise*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

8) **A**

Chaos means a lack of order, sense, or direction. Thus, the opposite of *order* is chaos. *Unity* is oneness. Thus, the opposite of unity is *division*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

9) **B**

Reckless means behaving dangerously or unwisely. Thus, someone who is reckless lacks *caution*. *Conviction* is the quality of being certain or sure. Thus, someone who is *doubtful* lacks conviction. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

10) **A**

A *fork* is a type of *utensil*. A *jet* is a type of *airplane*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.
